By car

You can park at the community center.

By train & bus

The nearest station is JR Numanohata. It is 5 min walk to the center. No marking.

No food or shoes are allowed in the sports hall. Please change into the slippers provided and eat in the kitchen (melon cafeteria) or designated areas within the building. You will receive number card, rental Emit, melon and corn voucher. The same number card and Emit will be used for 2 days. Please bring pin by yourself.

Competition information

Rules

The competition will be organized based on the rules defined by Japan Orienteering Association. The age for class is as of March 31, 2026. There are no restrictions on clothing or footwear used for the techniques.

Special rules

To alert wild animals (especially brown bears and Ezo deer), participants must bring a bear bell that makes a loud noise and have it checked with other items (Emit, number card, and compass) before getting on the bus to the terrain. We also recommend that beginners bring a whistle.

In the unfortunate event that you encounter a brown bear during the competition, please priorities your own safety first. If possible, choose the widest possible route and proceed to the finish line or notify the rescue staff. The competition officials will then use multiple vehicles to sound horns and whistles intermittently to notify competitors that the competition has been suspended. Additionally, in certain classes (including those for participants with hearing impairments), control units will be covered with garbage bags. At the finish line and competition center, please ensure you do a return check using your Emit.

Communication and GPS devices may be used unless you do not use them during your running. We actually recommend that elderly participants and beginners bring them with them. In the event of injury or when assisting others, or if it is impossible to return to the finish line within the competition time limit, participants are requested to actively use the emergency contact information provided. The emergency contact information is listed on the back of the map. Assisting injured people takes priority over participating in the competition, and using communication devices for this purpose will not result in disqualification or other penalties. Communication is possible within approximately 70-80% of the terrain.

The competition takes place in forests preserved within a vast industrial development area that was formerly a dairy farming region. Except for the observation tower, the highest elevation is only 18 meters, represented by just few contour lines. Due to death of bamboo and intensive deer grazing, the terrain has become more runnable since the last event, promising a fast-paced race.

Day 1 – Middle distance

The middle-distance course is set within a relatively compact area. For top classes, overlapping leg lines will require precise navigation to avoid confusion with nearby controls. Due to external constraints, the start and finish locations are fixed, and the limited number

of paths makes it difficult to design shorter courses. As a result, lower classes may find the course slightly more challenging.

You will take a bus from the competition center to the terrain. You are assigned to one of five buses in the starting list. The time schedule is

①12:00, ②12:20, ③12:40, ④13:05, and ⑤13:30. The ride is about 15 minutes. It will take about 10 minutes (600m) from the bus stop to the competition area.

Start area is same for all classes. Water is available.

Map scale is 1:10,000 for M21E·W21E·M21A·M21AS and 1:7,500 for the others. One marked route exists on the map.

The competition time is 90 minutes. You must reach the finish even if you have not finished your course. The bus will take you back to the completion center. Read Emit at the competition center.

Day 2 - Long distance

The long-distance course emphasizes route choice and straight-line navigation. Some bulldozer tracks created for archaeological surveys are not reflected on the map, but the course has been designed to minimize their impact on competition.

You will take a bus from the competition center to the terrain. You are assigned to one of 5 buses in the starting list. The time schedule is

①09:10, ②9:30, ③9:55, ④10:15, and ⑤10:40. The ride is about 20 minutes.

Organizer will transport participants from starting area 1 to starting are 2 by ban. This will take 5 minutes. Water is available in both starting areas.

The competition time is 180 minutes. You must reach the finish even if you have not finished your course. The bus will take you back to the completion center. Read Emit at the competition center.


